



GUIDE SHEET: BACKPACK & CHALK

LABEL AND TRY TO USE THESE WORDS IN CONVERSATION WITH YOUR CHILD THIS WEEK:

Beach Ball

Colors:

white
blue

Action Words:

seeing and searching
drawing and coloring

Names of Objects:

Bowling pins
chalk
bubbles and wand

Textures:

bumpy texture on the sidewalk
hard chalk
delicate bubbles

Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.

- Invite your child to tell about his/her experiences: Have you ever colored with chalk before? What else could you put in your backpack?
- Asking questions to help your child with reasoning: What would happen if you colored over your chalk picture with another color of chalk?
- Creative Play: Ask your child to identify the different animals on the pins. Can you arrange the pins in a triangle or circle? Ask your child to kick the ball to knock them over.

REMEMBER



Encourage your child to **TALK**
ASK the child questions
LISTEN to the child's answers
ADD to his/her comments

ENCOURAGE
Curiosity

Encourage the child to **WANT TO LEARN**
PRAISE when the child does well
Try to **IGNORE** mistake
HELP when the child really needs it
