



## GUIDE SHEET: CORDUROY

LABEL AND TRY TO USE THESE WORDS IN CONVERSATION WITH YOUR CHILD THIS WEEK:

**Colors:**

green overalls  
pink coat  
brown teddy bear  
blue purse

**Shapes & sizes:**

large & thick mattress  
round button  
pointy shoes

**Relationships:**

up & down the escalator  
in and out of bed  
under the covers

**Feelings:**

sad  
happy  
surprised  
sleepy

**Action Words:**

climbing  
hugging  
pulling  
falling

Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.

- Invite your child to tell about his/her experiences: *Have you ever been on an escalator? Do you have a favorite stuffed animal?*
- Ask questions about the pictures to help your child reason things out: *Why is Corduroy so happy at the end of the book?*
- Imaginary play: Have a tea party for your stuffed animals.

Encourage your child to TALK  
ASK the child questions  
LISTEN to the child's answers  
ADD to his/her comments

Encourage the child to WANT TO LEARN  
PRAISE when the child does well  
Try to IGNORE mistakes  
HELP when the child really needs it
