



## GUIDE SHEET: FARM PUZZLE


LABEL AND TRY TO USE THESE WORDS IN CONVERSATION WITH YOUR CHILD THIS WEEK:

Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.

- Invite your child to tell about his/her experiences: *Have you ever been to a real farm? What's your favorite animal?*
- Fitting: *Let's see if we can put the animal pieces in the puzzle. Where do they go?*
- Sounds: *What sound does each animal make? Can you make that animal sound?*
- Relationships: *Put the animal in the top space. Which animals have four legs? What is the pig next to? What colors are on the cow?*
