
### Textures:

Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.

- Invite your child to tell about his/her experiences: Many objects are found in a home, and a child will be familiar with them. Ask them to tell you what they know about them.
- Ask questions about the pictures to help your child reason things out: Why would you choose to wear a raincoat? Gloves? Boots?
- Talk about opposites: Use real examples to show heavy and light, old and new, clean and dirty, wet and dry.
