Frustrated

Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.

- Invite your child to tell about his/her experiences: *Do you like to listen to stories at night? What is your favorite story? Do you ever get scared? What are you makes you feel better?*
- Ask questions about the pictures to help your child reason things out: *Where was mama llama when little llama got upset? Far away? Nearby?*
- Talk about the feelings of the little llama: *How do you think the little llama felt when he read the book with mom? Why? How do you think little llama felt when he was alone in his bedroom? Why?*

REMEMBER



Encourage the child to WANT TO LEARN
PRAISE when the child does well
Try to IGNORE mistakes
HELP when the child really needs it
