



GUIDE SHEET: LOLA AT THE LIBRARY

LABEL AND TRY TO USE THESE WORDS IN CONVERSATION WITH YOUR CHILD THIS WEEK:

Colors:

green backpack
pink socks
white bracelet
blue shoes

Textures:

soft blanket
fuzzy rug
hard book

Actions:

walking to the library
reading stories
singing songs
choosing books

The names of objects:

library card
machine
books

Relationships:

inside backpack
on her back
on the shelf

Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.

- Invite your child to tell about his/her experiences: Have you been to the library? What kind of books would you choose?
- Ask questions about the pictures to help your child reason things out: Why does Lola go to the library? Why does Lola return books? What does Lola do at the library?
- Activity: Try going to your local library and checking out books!

REMEMBER

Encourage the child to WANT TO LEARN
PRAISE when the child does well
Try to IGNORE mistakes
HELP when the child really needs it
