



GUIDE SHEET: MARY HAD A LITTLE LAMB AND PUPPETS

Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.

- Ask questions about the pictures or puppet: What does a lamb say? Where is the lamb going? What is the puppet doing?
- Colors: Say the colors of the pictures or puppet. "This puppet is green!"
- Labeling Label the animals of each puppet. Have the puppet jump, dance or wave.
- General: Sing "Mary Had a Little Lamb" with your child. Encourage your child to put the puppet on their hand.

REMEMBER
