

Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.

- Invite your child to tell about his/her experiences: What job would you like to do when you grow up? Why?
- Sorting and Matching: Can you sort the pieces into groups: tops? Pants? By color?
- Activity: Let us pretend to be a firefight, a chef, a superhero or police officer!

REMEMBER

Encourage your child to TALK
ASK the child questions
LISTEN to the child's answers
ADD to his/her comments

HELP when the child really needs it
