Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.

- Invite your child to tell about his/her experiences: *Do you like busy days? What do you do when you are playing with your friends and family?*
- Ask questions about the pictures to help your child reason things out: *What do you want to be when you grow up? What do your parents or grandparents do for work?*
- Activity: *There is a pretending page in this book. Can you find it and think of more things that you could pretend to be?*

Encourage the child to **WANT TO LEARN**  
**PRAISE** when the child does well  
Try to **IGNORE** mistakes  
**HELP** when the child really needs it
