Asleep and awake


**Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.**

- Invite your child to tell about his/her experiences: *Ask your child if they have ever seen an elephant before? Or a porcupine? Talk about what animals they like the best in the book, or what their favorite animal sound is?*
- Ask questions about the pictures to help your child reason things out: *Do you think it is cold or hot outside? What do you think the animals like to eat?*
- For more fun with your child: *Count all the crocodile's sharp teeth, sing songs about crocodiles, make some of the animal's sounds and encourage your child to join in.*
