


Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.

- Invite your child to tell about his/her experiences: *What do you do when you are scared? Have you ever seen a bear?*
- Ask questions about the pictures to help your child reason things out: *What happened to make the family scared? Did the family have fun?*
- Activity: *Act out this story by pretending to walk through tall grass, mud, and so forth. Go outside on a beautiful day and name things in nature. Make a cave out of blankets and pillows and pretend to be a bear.*
