


Umagneey Ficiladada. Ku dhiira geli ilmahaaga inuu kuu sharaxo ficiladiisa



square


Counting:

Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.


- General: *Count the beads with your child. Show them how to slide the beads around the maze. Repeat the pattern colors "green, red, green, red."*
- Labeling: *This red circle is going up. The purple square is falling.*
- Play: *How many beads can slide together? Let's spin the beads around the maze.*

REMEMBER



Encourage your child to TALK
ASK the child questions
LISTEN to the child's answers
ADD to his/her comments

Encourage the child to WANT TO LEARN
PRAISE when the child does well
Try to IGNORE mistake
HELP when the child really needs it
