



GUIDE SHEET: JUNGLE ANIMALS

LABEL AND TRY TO USE THESE WORDS IN CONVERSATION WITH YOUR CHILD THIS WEEK:

Animals:

Tiger
Cubs (baby tiger)
Elephant
Calves (baby elephant)
Gorilla
Silverback (male gorilla)

Actions:

Elephant Tusks **dig** for food
Young gorillas **build** nests
Tigers **hunt** for food
Tigers **leap** high
Gorillas **communicate** well
Elephants **eats** grass

Labels:

Trunk
Tusks
Claws
Sharp teeth
Long arms

Describe your actions. Encourage your child to describe actions.

- **General:** *What are some of the difference between the momma and baby animals?*
- **Labeling:** *Can you find the elephant's trunk? Where do you think we can find the tigers claws?*
- **Invite your child to tell about his/her experiences:** *Have you seen a tiger? Elephant? Gorilla? Where did you see the animals? What sound did they make?*

REMEMBER

Encourage your child to **TALK**
ASK the child questions
LISTEN to the child's answers
ADD to his/her comments

Try to **IGNORE** mistake
