ACCOMPANIED TRANSPORTATION

Our JFCS Senior Services professional staff works closely with adults 60 years of age and older and their families to ensure safe, supported and independent living at home and provide resources, education and respite for caregivers.

Accompanied Transportation services offer clients assistance getting to and from medical appointments. We will pick you up at home, drive you to your appointment, wait for you at the appointment and then drive you back home. Services are available on a sliding-fee scale—call for more information.

Who can use this service?

- > Riders must be able to transfer in and out of the car independently
- > Foldable walkers are acceptable; unfortunately, we cannot accommodate wheelchairs
- > Service dogs are welcome (No other pets)

How do I set up a ride?

- > After you are registered and you need a ride, call your Case Manager at least six business days in advance and we will set up your ride

Where can I go?

- > The program serves the greater Minneapolis area, with some geographic restrictions. See a map of the service area on the back of this flyer.
- > This service is limited to two trips per month
- > Rides must be cancelled at least 1 business day in advance or you will be charged

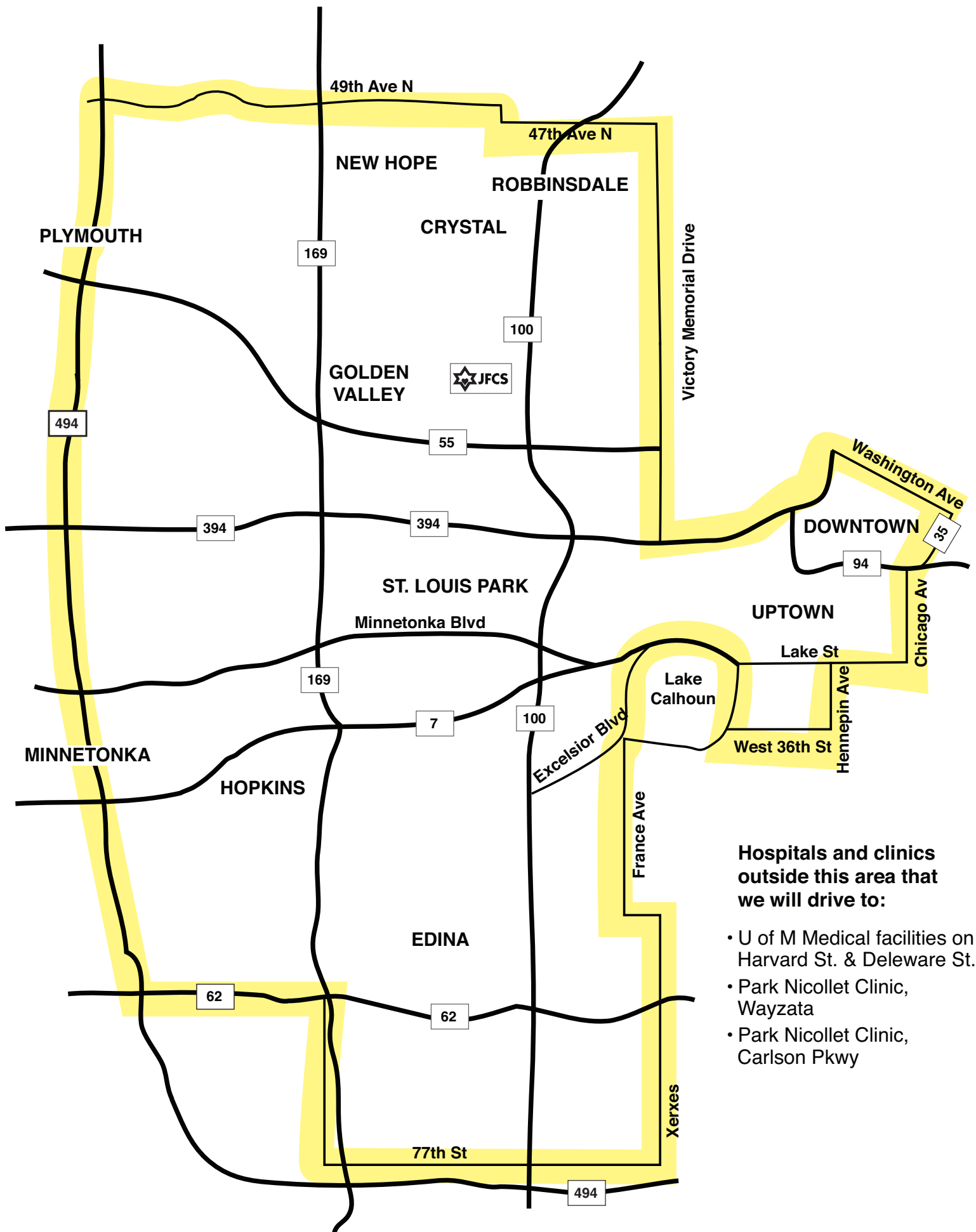
