

SHOPPING SERVICES

Our JFCS Senior Services professional staff works closely with adults 60 years of age and older and their families to ensure safe, supported and independent living at home and provide resources, education and respite for caregivers.

Shopping services provide clients with a personal escort for grocery shopping and other errands. The shopper provides transportation, and clients have the opportunity to make three stops in each two-hour session.

Who can use the Shopping service?

- > Anyone can use this service to schedule weekly or bi-monthly shopping trips
- > If you are unable to go out, the shopper will shop for you

How do I enroll in Shopping Services?

- > Register by calling 952-546-0616
- > After you are registered, service is provided on a regular schedule

Where can I go?

- > You can go to the grocery store, pharmacy, bank, or other personal errands; up to three stops per shopping trip

How much does this service cost?

- > Fee will be determined during the registration process. A sliding-fee scale is available.
- > Minimum charge of two hours per trip
- > Shopping trips must be cancelled at least 24 hours in advance or you will be billed
